1. Application details

The application for a proposed PRC plan was received by the administering authority on 17/01/2025.

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2. Decision on requested extension to the information response period

Your request to extend the information response period has been approved. The information response period has been extended and will now end on 8/12/2025.

3. Reasons for the decision

Fairhill Coking Coal Pty Ltd has internal approvals in place and groundwater consultants ready to commence, estimating an 8-week reporting timeline subject to data availability and flood modelling inputs. Engagement with the flood modelling consultant is pending due to prioritisation of the Wilton ERC application. While the 8-week timeframe appears achievable, the proposed extension to 8 December would allow additional time for redrafting rehabilitation areas and addressing any further requirements arising from flood modelling. Fairhill Coking Coal Pty Ltd has also indicated plans to undertake a review and gap analysis of the completed waste characterisation data.
