I confirm that an application for a decision on the estimated rehabilitation cost (ERC) for the Yarrabee Coal Mine has been lodged with the Department, as a requirement under the provisions of the *Environmental Protection Act 1994* and Environmental Authority EPML00844613.

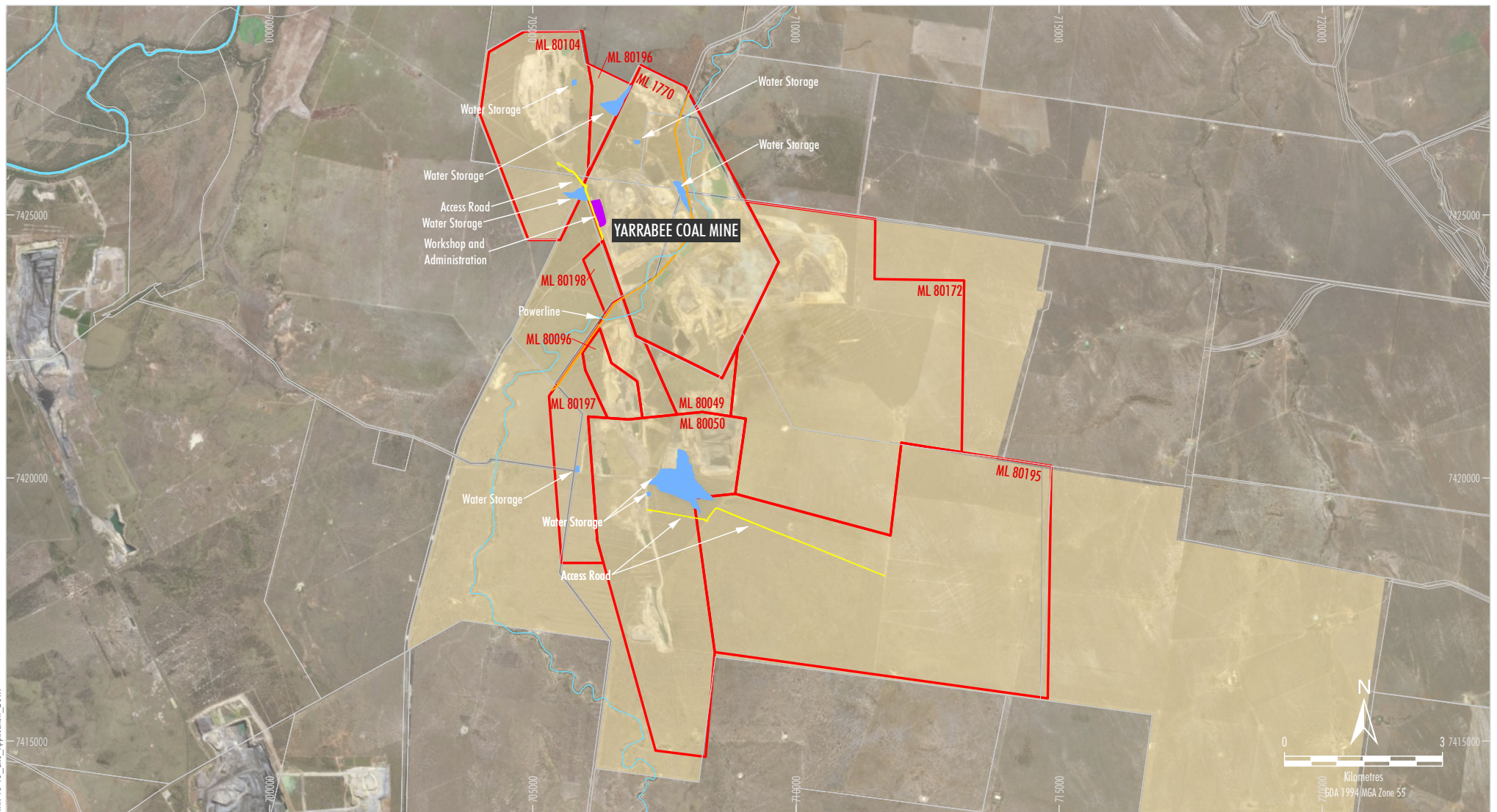
