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## CONDITIONS OF ENVIRONMENTAL AUTHORITY

### General Permit Condition

#### Agency Interest: General

- PG1 The environmental authority does not take effect until the grant of the tenure to the environmental authority holder, or until each environmental authority holder has become a holder, under the Mineral Resources Act 1989, of each of relevant mining tenements.
- PG2 The conditions of this environmental authority are in force until a surrender of the authority is accepted pursuant to the Environmental Protection Act 1994. The conditions apply unless an amendment is approved pursuant to the Environmental Protection Act 1994.
- PG3 Financial assurance
- The environmental authority holder is to give the administering authority a financial assurance in the amount and form and at a time required by the administering authority.
- PG4 The environmental authority holder must comply with each of the Standard Environmental Conditions contained in the Code of Environmental Compliance for Mining Lease Projects.

#### Agency Interest: Biodiversity

- PB1 The holder of the environmental authority is authorised to carry out mining activities within the Category B Environmentally Sensitive Area described as Endangered Regional Ecosystem, provided that the activities do not cause any significant environmental harm to the area.
- PB2 The holder of the environmental authority must ensure that clearing of mature trees is prevented or minimised where practicable.
- PB3 Important Note: In regard to complying with standard environmental condition 36, the environmental authority holder must spread seeds or plant species that will promote revegetation of a similar species and density cover to that of the pre disturbed areas of Endangered Regional Ecosystem.
