CONDITIONS OF ENVIRONMENTAL AUTHORITY

General Permit Condition

Agency Interest: General

- (A1) The conditions of this environmental authority are in force until a surrender of the authority is accepted pursuant to the Environmental Protection Act 1994. The conditions apply unless an amendment is approved pursuant to the Environmental Protection Act 1994.
- (A2) The environmental authority holder is to give the administering authority a financial assurance in the amount and form and at a time required by the administering authority.
- (A3) The environmental authority holder must comply with each of the Standard Environmental Conditions contained in the Code of Environmental Compliance for Mining Lease Projects dated January 2001.

Schedule B - Additional conditions

Standard Environmental Condition 14 of the Code states:

The holder of the environmental authority must not carry out activities :

1. in, or within 2km of, a category A environmentally sensitive area; or
2. in, or within 1km of, a category B environmentally sensitive area.

Prior to carrying out activities in a category C environmentally sensitive area, consult with the relevant administering authority. If it is determined through the consultation that additional conditions are necessary, the holder must comply with those conditions.

(B1) The environmental authority holder is authorised to carry out activities within the areas of endangered regional ecosystems.

Condition B1 is an additional condition that overrides Standard Environmental Condition (SEC) 14 to the extent that SEC 14 prohibits the holder of the environmental authority carrying out activities within an endangered regional ecosystem (Category B) environmentally sensitive area.

(B2) The holder of the Environmental Authority must consult with the Environmental Protection Agency to identify the specific values that must be preserved within the area identified as an endangered regional ecosystem; and

(B3) The Environmental Authority holder must consult with the Environment Protection Agency prior to commencing rehabilitation to determine a seed mix that will be appropriate for the region.

(B4) The environmental authority holder must ensure that track intensity in the areas identified as having an Endangered Regional Ecosystem does not exceed 1:500m (one track intersecting on each 500m grid) and must ensure minimal vegetation disturbance.
