CONDITIONS OF ENVIRONMENTAL AUTHORITY

General Permit Condition

Agency Interest: General

- PG1 The environmental authority does not take effect until the grant of the tenure to the environmental authority holder, or until each environmental authority holder has become a holder, under the Mineral Resource Act 1989, of each of the relevant mining tenements.
- PG2 The Conditions of this environmental authority are in force until a surrender of the authority is accepted pursuant to the *Environmental Protection Act 1994*. The conditions apply unless an amendment is approved pursuant to the *Environmental Protection Act 1994*.
- PG3 **Financial Assurance**
The environmental authority holder is to give the administering authority a financial assurance in the amount and form and at the time required by the administering authority.
- PG4 The environmental authority holder must comply with each of the *Standard Environmental Conditions contained in the Code of Environmental Compliance for Mining Lease Projects*.
- PG5 All exploration activities carried out on the mining leases must comply with each of the Standard Environmental Conditions contained in the most recent version of the *Code of Environmental Compliance for Exploration and Mineral Development Projects*.
