## CONDITIONS OF ENVIRONMENTAL AUTHORITY

### General Permit Condition

Agency Interest: General

- PG1 The environmental authority does not take effect until the grant of the tenure to the environmental authority holder, or until each environmental authority holder has become a holder, under the Mineral Resource Act 1989, of each of the relevant mining tenements.
- PG2 The Conditions of this environmental authority are in force until a surrender of the authority is accepted pursuant to the Environmental Protection Act 1994. The conditions apply unless an amendment is approved pursuant to the Environmental Protection Act 1994.
- PG5 All exploration activities carried out on the mining leases must comply with each of the Standard Environmental Conditions contained in the most recent version of the Code of Environmental Compliance for Exploration and Mineral Development projects.
- PG4 The environmental authority holder must comply with each of the Standard Environmental Conditions contained in the Code of Environmental Compliance for Mining Lease Projects.
- PG3 **Financial Assurance**  
The environmental authority holder is to give the administering authority a financial assurance in the amount and form and at the time required by the administering authority.
