CONDITIONS OF ENVIRONMENTAL AUTHORITY

General Permit Condition

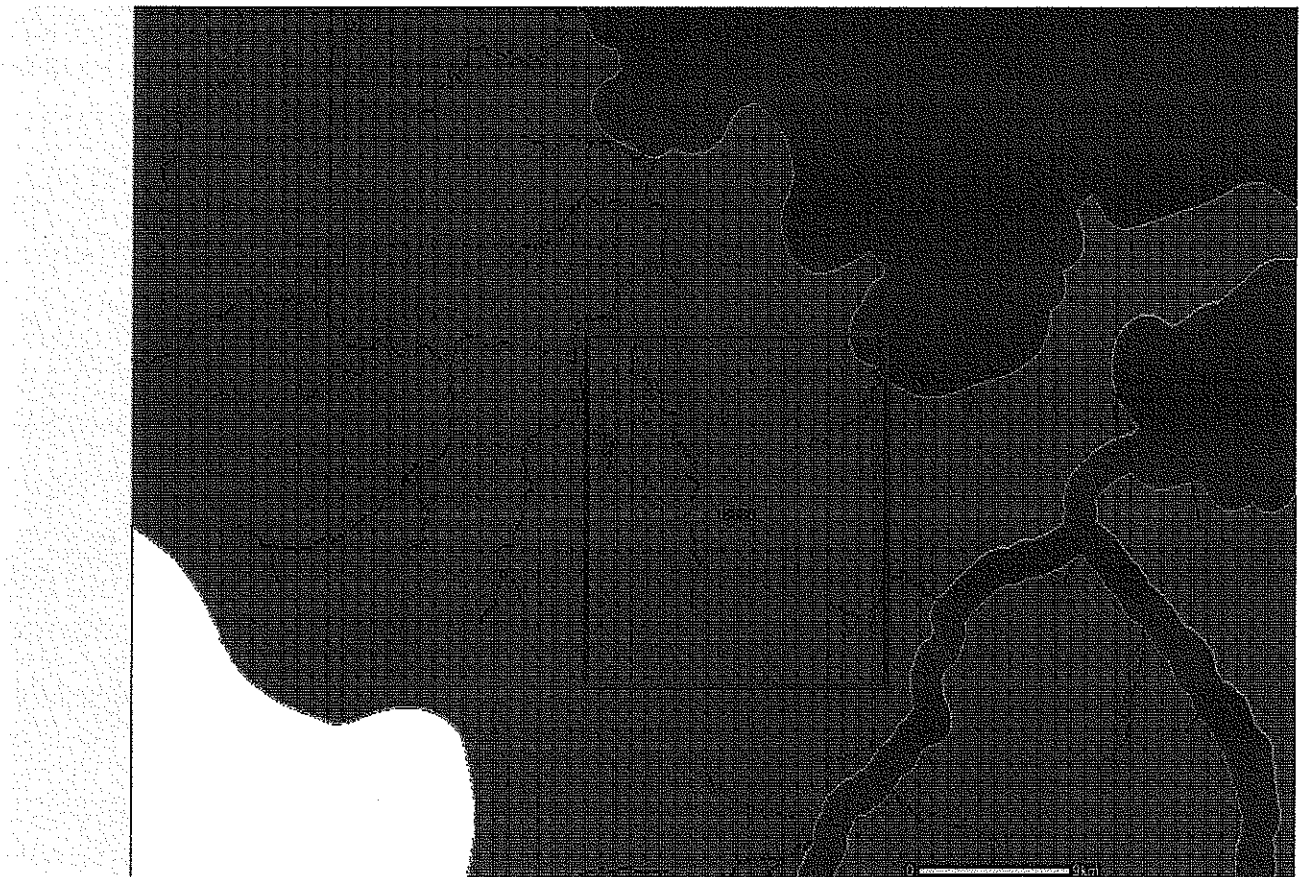
Agency Interest: General

- G1 The conditions of this Environmental Authority are in force until a surrender of the authority is accepted pursuant to the *Environmental Protection Act 1994*. The conditions apply unless an amendment is approved pursuant to the *Environmental Protection Act 1994*.
- G2 The Environmental Authority does not take effect until the grant of the tenure to the Environmental Authority holder, or until each Environmental Authority holder has become a holder, under the *Mineral Resources Act 1989*, of each of the relevant mining tenements.
- G3 The Environmental Authority holder is to give the administering authority a financial assurance in the form and at a time required by the administering authority.
- G4 The Environmental Authority holder must comply with each of the Standard Environmental Conditions contained in the Code of Environmental Compliance for Exploration and Mineral Development.

Agency Interest: Water

- WA1 Contaminated wastewater must not enter receiving waters of a watercourse or lake in a high preservation area or a nominated waterway (Figure 1 EPM 18580).
