- (A1-1) For exploration activities the environmental authority holder must comply with each of the standard environmental conditions contained in the *Code of Environmental Compliance for Exploration and Mineral Development Projects*.
- (A1-2) The conditions of this environmental authority are in force until surrender of the authority is accepted pursuant to the *Environmental Protection Act 1994*. The conditions apply unless an amendment is approved pursuant to the *Environmental Protection Act 1994*.
- (A1-3) If there is any inconsistency between a standard environmental condition referred and an additional condition in this environmental authority, the additional condition prevails to the extent of any inconsistency.
- (A1-4) All outstanding rehabilitation undertaken on mining tenure MDL190 must be rehabilitated in accordance with this Environmental Authority.
