Subject: RE: Cows Coal Mine transitional PRCP meeting postponed/request to extend IR period

Hi Brad, as discussed on the phone this afternoon, the PRCP team and BCC will not be in a position to provide meaningful feedback to QCoal about the transitional PRCP for Cows Coal Mine by tomorrow afternoon.

Therefore, it is requested that the meeting be rescheduled. This is both due to the significant workload experienced by the PRCP team as well as the need to work through the application of the guideline requirements to Cows, and to transitional PRCPs more generally, to ensure a consistent approach going forward.

The department is requesting QCoal's agreement to extend the information request period to **Friday 22 April 2021** pursuant to s145(3) of the EP Act.

It is also proposed that the department and QCoal meet on Monday **19 April 2021** to discuss the outcomes from the combined PRCP and BCC review of the PRCP submission. The department will provide QCoal with a summary of the items that will be raised prior to the meeting.

Every effort will be made to complete the review and provide feedback earlier than expected. BCC will continue to provide regular updates to QCoal about how the process is progressing.
