Information Notice - Temporary emissions licence

As statutory notice was originally issued on 3 March 2022 by the administering authority pursuant to section 357F of the Environmental Protection Act 1994 (the Act) to advise you of a decision to grant the application for a temporary emissions licence on different terms than have been requested in the application. On 3 June 2022, this amended non-statutory information notice was issued to advise of an amendment of a temporary emissions licence in accordance with section 357J(b) of the Act.

Amendment of temporary emissions licence (TEL) for flood impacted sewage pumping stations at the following sewage pumping stations described below.

1 Application details

The application for a temporary emissions licence was received by the administering authority on 2 March 2022.

A request to amend the temporary emissions license was received by the administering authority on 25 May 2022

Application reference number: A-TEL-NEW-100214374

2 Decision

On 3 March 2022, the administering authority decided to grant the application as submitted. However, it is noted that the following sewage pumping stations were not included in the temporary emissions licence as they are not authorised locations under the environmental authority EA0001209: SP366 – 168 Woodend Road, Woodend; Pump station SP380 – 126 Bognuda Street, Bundamba; and Pump Station SP324 – Old Toowoomba Road, Amberley.

The administering authority has decided to amend the TEL (A-TEL-NEW-100214374) with written agreement from the EA holder on 3 June 2022.

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Authorised activity: ERA 63 Sewage treatment (2) operating a sewage pumping station mentioned in subsection (1)(b).

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TEL-2	Release to land and waters Contaminants must not be released to land or waters (including the bed and banks of any waters) as a result of the activity. The only exception to this condition is that a sewage release to land or waters (including the bed and banks or any waters) may occur as a result of the activity only when the following apply: (a) the release is (i) as a result of a wet weather event; or		

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	(ii) the following has occurred: 1. hydraulic flow into the sewage pumping station exceeds the peak design capacity of the sewage pumping(s) at the time the contaminants are released; or 2. the sewage pumping station is not operational due to power failure, inundation, or critical impacts due to flooding; or 3. the sewage pumping station is not operational due to critical component being removed to protect the asset; and (b) all reasonable and practicable measures have been taken to prevent the release; and (c) the administering authority has been notified in accordance with condition TEL-3 of this temporary emissions licence (TEL).
TEL-3	A notification report must be provided to the administering authority's Pollution Hotline every calendar month, commencing from 30 June 2022 and for the duration of this temporary emissions licence, advising the following for all sewage pumping station releases to the environment: (a) the number and location of sewage pumping stations that have released during the past month; and (b) the number of sewage pumping stations actively releasing; and (c) the date the release began and finished; and (d) the estimated volume of the sewage released; and (e) the event, nature, circumstances and response to the release; and (f) results from water quality monitoring of releases undertaken in accordance with condition TEL-5; and (g) a summary of all investigations including the results, determinations and outcomes required under condition TEL-4 (h) for all sewage pumping stations identified under Table TEL-1: Applicable SPS, relevant conditions, and TEL duration, the remaining recovery actions required to be undertaken and associated timeframes.
TEL-4	An investigation into the environmental impact of any notifiable release must be conducted to determine: (a) the environmental impact to surface waters of the release. This must consider: (i) the results of the water quality monitoring conducted under condition TEL-4; and (ii) the results of receiving environmental monitoring obtained under condition 6 of environmental authority EA0001209; and (iii) the relevant environmental values and associated water quality objectives; and (b) recommended action(s) to mitigate any adverse impacts caused, or likely to be caused, by the activity in respect of contaminant releases to surface waters.

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TEL-5	The action(s) identified under condition TEL-4(c) must be undertaken: (a) as soon as practicable, but no more than 14 days after completing the investigation; or (b) another period agreed to in writing by the administering authority.																				
TEL-6	The holder of this TEL must monitor the following parameters for notifiable releases to surface waters, at the locations, and at the frequency specified in Table TEL-2: TEL Monitoring Requirements until such time as all discharges cease. Definitions

The following definitions apply to this temporary emissions licence:

Activity means the environmentally relevant activity(s) to which the environmental authority relates. An activity may be undertaken on the whole or a part of a site.

Administering authority means the Chief Executive administering the *Environmental Protection Act 1994*.

Appropriately qualified person means a person or persons who has professional qualifications, training, skills and experience relevant to the environmental authority (EA) requirements and can give authoritative assessment, advice and analysis in relation to the EA requirements using the relevant protocols, standards, methods and/or literature.

Groundwater means water that occurs naturally in, or is introduced artificially into, an aquifer.

Land means land excluding waters and the atmosphere.

Notifiable Release means a sewage release that:

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- (a) poses a threat to public health (for example, contamination of **waters** with primary recreation values);
- (b) results in any observable environmental impact (for example, fish kill, distress to wildlife, marine plants or other aquatic life);
- (c) discharges to, or is likely to impact, a sensitive environment (for example, Ramsar wetland, marine park, or area designated as a conservation zone under a relevant planning scheme); or
- (d) is 10 000 L or more.

Surface water means **waters** other than **groundwater**.

Waters means a river, stream, lake, lagoon, pond, swamp, wetland, unconfined surface water, unconfined water, natural or artificial watercourse, bed and bank of any waters, dams, non-tidal or tidal waters (including the sea), stormwater channel, stormwater drain, roadside gutter, stormwater run-off, and groundwater and any part thereof.
