1 Application details

Application for temporary emissions licence (TEL) for the release of stormwater under varied release conditions.

2 Decision

Thank you for your application for a temporary emissions licence. Your application, which was received by this office on 4 February 2026, has been granted as submitted

3 Reason for the decision

The administering authority has decided the application in accordance with sections 357C - 357G of the *Environmental Protection Act 1994*.

The administering authority has determined that heavy rainfall associated with the Ex-Tropical Cyclone Koji has resulted in a significant accumulation of stormwater within subsidence areas onsite at Gregory Crinum Mine which cannot be release under existing conditions of the Environmental Authority.

4 Human rights

A human rights assessment was carried out in relation to this decision and it was determined that the decision is compatible with human rights.

5 Review and appeal rights

You may apply to the administering authority for a review of this decision within 10 business days after receiving this notice. You may also appeal against this internal review decision to the Land Court. Information about your review and appeal rights is attached to this notice. This information is guidance only and you may have other legal rights and obligations.

6 Temporary emissions licence

This temporary emissions licence commences on 4 February and ends on 25 March 2026.

The licence permits the following emission:

- The release of 725ML of stormwater from the Crinum East subsidence zone at TEL RP1 located at Crackers Gully

The licence overrides the following conditions of your environmental authority, approval number EPML00945013:

- Condition W37 (replaced by TEL W37 and Table W13 TEL)

The following conditions apply to this licence:

TEL W37	Stormwater, other than mine affected water, is permitted to be released to waters from: i) erosion and sediment control structures that are installed and operated in accordance with the Erosion and Sediment Control Plan required by condition W36; and ii) water management infrastructure that is installed and operated, in accordance with a Water Management Plan that complies with conditions W31 to W33 inclusive, for the purpose of ensuring water does not become mine affected water; and iii) the release location specified in Table W13 TEL - Alternative Stormwater Release Points, Sources and Receiving Waters
